Special card makes online banking safer

Once you log in, some banks give you total access. So, there is only a single barrier to your accounts.

If criminals guess or steal your password, your money is gone.

Many banks are implementing two-factor authentication. This adds a second barrier. There are a number of ways to do this. Some are better than others.

Only [Bank of America](#) is offering SafePass. The six-digit code isn't required to log in. But some online banking features (like money transfers and bill pay) are locked. The SafePass code unlocks them.

A six digit code is sent to your cell for free. Or you may purchase the SAFECARD for \$20.

Pushing the button on the card generates a six digit code. You enter that code into your browser to unlock the features you want to use.

The code may be used once for 10 minutes.

PAYING YOUR BILLS AT A FREE WIFI SPOT

Most public Wi-Fi hotspots have virtually no security. That is especially true for free ones. **HOWEVER –**

Financial organizations use SSL (Secure Sockets Layer). It is a secure connection, using encryption that has never been broken. Even if your information were intercepted, it could not be read.

When you make a secure connection, the Web address begins with HTTPS. Sites that are not secure use HTTP. You may also see a closed lock at the bottom of the page.

Consider password protecting them with [MyLockbox](#). It's free

Just install the program, and specify a password and location.

You can drag files and folders to the lockbox. Then, once you close it, it disappears. The computer administrator can't access it. Nor can it be accessed via the Internet.

Close Windows' sharing

File and Printer Sharing allows a computer's resources to be shared on a local network.

According to Microsoft, Windows could include the Internet as part of your local network if you connect directly using a modem rather than through a router. Part of this confusion lies with your Internet provider's definition of its own local networks.

You could be sharing your files with just about anyone.

The easy way to prevent this is to disable File and Printer Sharing.

To do this in Windows XP, click Start>>Control Panel. Double-click Network Connections. Right-click your local area connection icon and select Properties from the menu.

Clear the checkbox labeled "File and Printer Sharing for Microsoft Networks." Then click OK. You should restart your computer to be sure the setting kicks in.
