



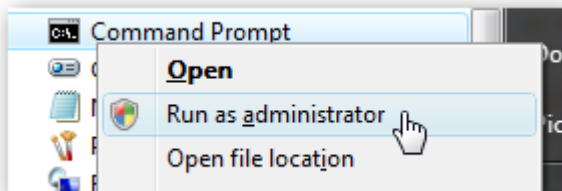

Show Administrator Login

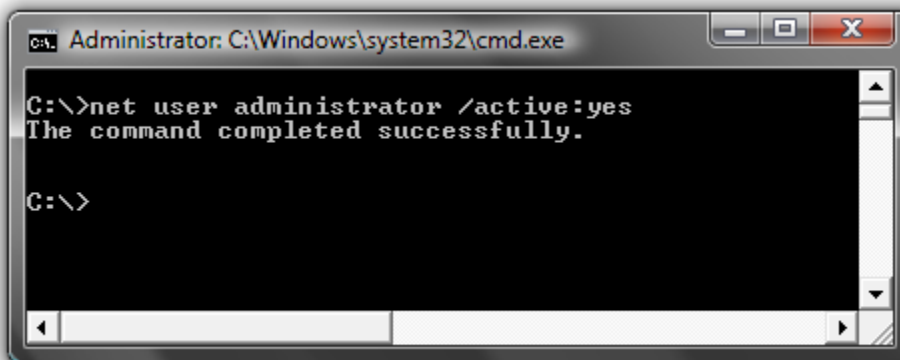
Win Vista, 7, 8

The Administrator login is hidden by default. One way to 'activate' the Administrator login is:

Windows Vista, 7, 8 Run the Command Prompt as Administrator. In Windows 7, type 'cmd' in the Search bar. You will see cmd.exe. Right click and choose 'Run as aadministrator'. If that does not work, you can find cmd.exe in Accessories in Start.

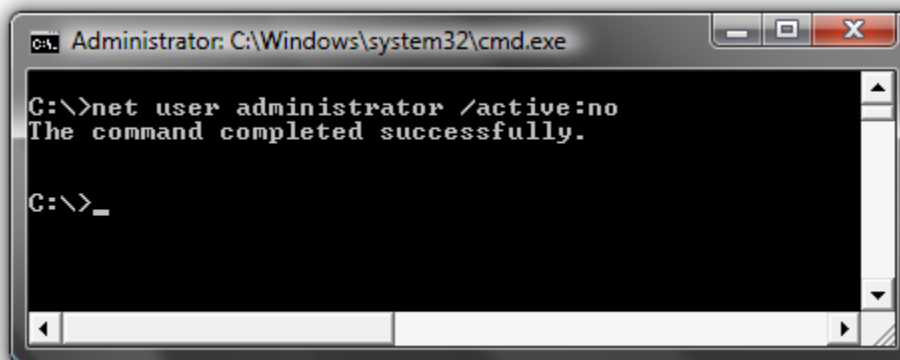


Type '**net user administrator /active:yes**'



To hide the Administrator login simply

Type '**net user administrator /active:no**'



NOTE: There is a good chance that the User Account you are using has administrator privileges. In that case, you will not have problems with Run as aadministrator. If you do not have those privileges, there is a good chance that your computer is set up so the Administrator password is blank. Again, no problems. If you setup an Administrator password but don't remember it, call.
