




Boot Directly to Account

It is possible to have your computer boot directly to your startup screen. This is how to set that.

Windows 7 and 8 *(Hold Windows key and press 'r' key to Run)*

A screen will appear asking for your password.

Enter your current password and confirm Click OK

Note: To simply CHANGE your password, hold Ctrl-Alt-Del and select 'Change Password'
This procedure is shown in the dialog box above as well.

Of course, if you don't want to use a password, just leave the password field blank.
