

MICROSOFT MOBILITY CENTER FOR LAPTOPS

For people who use Vista and Windows 7 on their laptops, Microsoft added a very useful little control panel called the **Mobility Center**. Now, this is not the regular control panel you have been used to for so many years. The goal of the Mobility Center is to easily let you configure small basic things with your PC. Simple tasks, such as checking the battery level, enabling or disabling wireless connections, attaching an external display or even muting the sound, for example. For heavy laptop users, it's a good idea to add a shortcut to the startup group to always have the Mobility Center ready for use. Or, you can Just hold the Windows key and hit the X key (**Win+X**) to access it as well.
