## How do I uninstall Java on my Windows computer ?

- **Platform(s):** Windows 7, Vista, Windows XP
- **Java version(s):** All Java Versions



Older versions of Java may appear in the program list as **J2SE**, **Java 2**, **Java SE** or **Java Runtime Environment**.

Remove older versions of Java in the same way as you would remove any other software from your Windows computer.

### Windows 7 and Vista - Uninstall Programs

1. Click **Start**
  2. Select **Control Panel**
  3. Select **Programs**
  4. Click **Programs and Features**
  5. Select the program you want to uninstall by clicking on it, and then click the

### Windows XP - Uninstall Programs

1. Click **Start**
2. Select **Control Panel**
3. Click the **Add/Remove Programs** control panel icon
4. The Add/Remove control panel displays a list of software on your system, including any Java software products that are on your computer. Select any that you want to uninstall by clicking on it, and then click the **Remove** button.
